Triangular Signs

Triangular signs provide **WARNINGS**. They help road users to anticipate hazards.



Warning: There may be pedestrians in the road



Warning: Level crossing with barrier



Warning: Dual Carriageway ends



Give Way

Red Circles

Red circles give prohibitive information. They illustrate what is forbidden by law. Put the word 'NO' in front of the picture and that is the meaning of the sign,



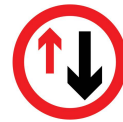
No Pedestrians allowed here



No Overtaking



No Motor Vehicles except solo motor cycles



Give priority to oncoming vehicles

Blue Signs

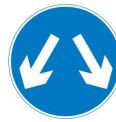
Blue signs give positive information.



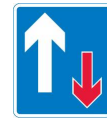
Shared cycle and pedestrian pathway



Minimum speed limit



Pass either side and reach the same destination



Traffic has priority over oncoming vehicles

Motorway Signs

Motorways will often have temporary signs illuminated on overhead gantries.



Temporary advisory speed limit



Lane closed. Do not proceed in this lane



All three lanes ahead are closed



Traffic must leave the motorway at the next junction

No vehicles



Open level crossing without lights ahead
